The FSS Program is a five year program, designed to help you become economically self-sufficient. Participants plan short and long term goals with their FSS Coordinator. As progress is made toward those goals and earnings increase, contributions may also be made to a special savings account.

When an FSS Participant reaches their final goal, the money in the escrow account can be used toward education, transportation or even a down payment on a home.
